1) To receive apologies

Due to Apologies by Councillor Mrs J Norman, Chair, Councillor J Evans was elected to Chair the Meeting.

2) To receive copy Report of Wellbeing of Future Generations Committee meeting held on 28th September 2016

Committee members had previously been circulated with a report of the Wellbeing of Future Generations Committee meeting held on 28th September 2016 and ratified at the Full Town Council Meeting on 27th October 2016. Noted.

3) To receive update on Annual Report 2016/2017

The Deputy Town Clerk updated Committee Members on the progress of the 2016/2017 Annual Report. She passed a draft copy of the Report to Committee Members to review and asked for any further ideas for inclusion in the Report to be forwarded to her. The Deputy Town Clerk confirmed the report would need to be completed by Mid-March 2017.

4) To discuss future projects for 2017/2018

Committee Members discussed future projects ideas for 2017/2018.

Following the success of the 2016 Llantwit Major Pantomime the Committee all agreed they would like to ensure this happens again next year and would recommend booking the same Touring Pantomime Company again. Committee Members discussed a date for booking this event.

The Committee discussed ideas for other events the Touring Company provide including Wrestling and Race Nights.

Committee Members wanted to continue to work in 2017/2018 towards a new Play Park at Trebeferad, Boverton.

Following the Town Study Steering Group Meeting on the 17th January 2017 Committee Members discussed ideas for creating Steel (laser cut) sculptures for display in Llantwit Major from the S106 Funding Money available to be spent on Public Art. Committee members thought that Steel Sheets depicting the Celtic Stones, positioned at the Railway Station, would encourage tourists to go down to the Church to see the original Celtic Stones.

Committee members also discussed planting wild flowers at various locations in Llantwit Major.

Committee Members suggested having a stall at the Victorian Fair Day to continue to promote Llantwit Major Town Council.
